TODAY'S SERVICE: Today we recognize the contributions of the LWML. Members of the Ladies Guild and Grace Evening Guild will participate in the service as ushers, greeters, and readers. Stop by their tables in the Welcome Center. The Handbell Choir will be heard at the 8AM service, and the Children's Choir will sing at 10:45AM.

ALTAR FLOWERS are given to the glory of God by The Holy Cross Ladies Guild and the Grace Evening Guild in observance of LWML Sunday.

DOOR OFFERING: After each worship service this weekend, a door offering will be collected to support LWML Mites for missions. Holy Cross has two LWML groups: Holy Cross Ladies Guild, which meets on the second Friday at 10AM (Oct. 11), and Grace Evening Guild, which meets on the second Tuesday at 6PM (Oct. 8). Both groups meet this week. All women in the congregation are invited to join them.

The **Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML)** was established in 1942 as the official women's auxiliary of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod. With the launch of a new logo in 2023, the acronym **LWML** is shifting towards the descriptive phrase **Lutheran Women** *in Mission*.

As Lutheran Women in Mission, we joyfully proclaim Christ, support missions, and equip women to honor God by serving others. On Lutheran Women in Mission Sunday, we remember our past and look to the future.

Mites & Missions: Based on the biblical account of the widow's mite (Luke 21:1–4), **the Mite Box** is intended for regular contributions of "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to congregations and the LCMS. The Mite Box is more than just a symbol of God's provision—it's a reminder that offerings and prayers bring the love and hope of Jesus to those in need. Pick up a Mite Box in the Welcome Center and add your extra change; bring it back monthly to empty it in the larger box found on the LWML table. As Lutheran Women in Mission, we serve God by serving others. Through a careful selection process, we choose mission grant recipients from around the world each biennium. In 2023, a Mission Goal of \$2,350,000 was approved to fund 31 grants by the national convention.



From the American Red Cross:

As Hurricane Helene has brought widespread, lifethreatening storm surges, flooding, and high winds throughout the Southeast, dozens of American Red Cross (ARC) blood drives have been canceled, impacting nearly 1,000 blood and platelet donations.

The ARC works closely with its partners and local officials to ensure help is available when and where people need it most. The Red Cross has already opened more than 100 shelters for 8,500 individuals who have evacuated their homes. More than 800 Red Cross workers are on the ground, ready to offer shelter, meals, relief supplies, emotional support, safety, and comfort to those impacted.

All blood types are needed, especially Type O Negative, as the universal blood type used in emergencies.
