


#### **ELDERS AND CONGREGANT COMMUNICATION**

STUDY GRANTS AVAILABLE: Attention High School Seniors and College Students planning a career in Church work: The Lutheran Women's Missionary League, Missouri District, has study grants available for the 2025-2026 school year. Men and women enrolled in a University or Seminary of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod preparing for full-time professional church work or as a colloquy student may apply. Applicants must be a member of a congregation located in the Missouri District of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod or of an English and SELC District congregation active in the LWML located in Missouri for 12 months before applying. The Study Grant program is unique as recipients are chosen according to financial need and commitment to Christian service. Completed applications must be received by mail or electronically by APRIL 15, 2025. Incomplete applications will not be considered. No application will be considered if not complete.





# **Lutheran Education Tuition Assistance**

Holy Cross Lutheran Church supports families who desire a Lutheran Education. Students who, along with parent(s) or legal guardian(s), are members of Holy Cross are eligible for Tuition assistance. Students must be enrolled in grades K-12 at an LCMS Lutheran school in St. Charles County or in a Concordia University System (LCMS) higher education institution.



Applications are in the Welcome Center and must be turned in by March 31.

# Grow + Serve in Christ

Lutheran High School began in 1982 with only 17 students in two classrooms in a trailer, housed on the grounds of Holy Cross Lutheran Church in O'Fallon. Enrollment grew, and the school moved several times before building its current facilities on Mexico Road in 1989.

More classrooms and spaces have been added to maintain an exceptional learning environment where students "Grow and Serve in Christ." The 2017 Reach Up, Reach In, Reach Out Capital Campaign funded a new chemistry lab, a STEM – Science, Technology, Engineering & Math – classroom, a music room, 3 new general-use classrooms, a library/media center, a lecture hall, and a new gym.

Now, it's time to finish what we started: With new major fundraising efforts, we will renovate nine additional classrooms and science labs, which have not been updated since the building was built. By investing in these renovations, we will create classrooms that reflect the excellence of our Christ-centered education while meeting the evolving needs of our students and teachers.

As part of that commitment, we seek to enhance the Commons, a space transformed from a gym to a multipurpose area during the 2018 Reach Campaign. While it continues to serve many needs, recent feedback has highlighted the importance of further renovations to create a more inviting environment for worship, performances, and gatherings. Planned upgrades – including increased stage space and improved lighting, sound, and operational enhancements – will enrich daily chapel service services, allowing students to grow spiritually in a space designed for worship and reflection. These improvements will support community events as well as student performances in theatre and music, ensuring the Commons becomes a vibrant hub where faith and fellowship thrive.

Through this renovation, we remain dedicated to equipping students to live out their faith and serve others in Christ's name. We deeply value your support, and while we are not asking for campaign contributions at this time, detailed information will be sent to each household during March and April.
