
# People of the Passion: WOMEN OF JERUSALEM

#### **Midweek Lent Theme**

This year's theme People of the Passion will focus on a different person or group of people as drawn from the passion reading from Luke's account in chapter 23.

## Week Three: The Daughters of Jerusalem (Luke 23:26-31)

Here is another section of the passion story that is unique to Luke's gospel and isn't spoken of in any of the other three Gospel accounts. In a day and age when the gift of children is something that is longed for and welcomed, Jesus now shares the opposite sentiment with these women, sharing that it would have been better to not have had children due to the evils in the world. These sentiments are still reflected in our society today with the ongoing challenge of raising faithful children in a world that sometimes seems so faithless.

A reading from Luke, chapter 23.

And as they led Him away, they seized one Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, and laid on him the cross, to carry it behind Jesus. <sup>27</sup>And there followed Him a great multitude of the people and of women who were mourning and lamenting for Him. <sup>28</sup>But turning to them Jesus said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. <sup>29</sup>For behold, the days are coming when they will say, 'Blessed are the barren and the wombs that never bore and the breasts that never nursed!'  $^{30}$ Then they will begin to say to the mountains, 'Fall on us,' and to the hills, 'Cover us.' 31 For if they do these things when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry?"



For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.


